WE ARE VERY GOOD

God is inviting us to come out of our box of sin and darkness, and into His healing light.

The path to sin was identified by the early Church Fathers. Although stages 1-3 are NOT sinful, they DO steal our time and energy. The earlier on the path we stop, the EASIER it is to stop.

PATH TO SIN

- Stage 1: Suggestion
- Stage 2: Conversation
- Stage 3: Struggle
- Stage 4: Consent to suggestion of evil
- Stage 5: Evil

“The light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light, because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed. But whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God.” John 3:19-21

ROCK #2 ~ Rosary
